



## Introduction to Mountmaking

#### **Basic Materials**

- Half round hand file - 2 cut
- Jeweler's Saw Frame
- Saw Blades
- Wet-Dry Sandpaper - 220, 320, 400 Grit - at least 1 sheet of each
- Fine tip Sharpie Marker
- Sketchbook and drawing pencils/pen
- Clear plastic ruler with Grid (1 or 2 inch wide x 12" long)
- Beeswax or cut Lube
- One tube "Propoxy 20"
- Paint brushes for detail painting with acrylics
- Scissors
- Tape – blue, clear or masking
- Manilla folder
- Ring forming pliers
- Flat stock forming pliers
- **Highly Recommended:**
- Smooth Jaw Flat Nose Parallel Plier 160 mm

#### **Metal Supply**

- Silver Solder Wire - Hard
- Silver Solder Wire – Medium (optional, as needed)

#### **Recommended, but Optional**

- Needle Files - Set of 6 - 2 cut
- Opti Visor or other magnification
- Flush or bevel cutters
- Chain nose pliers
- Flat nose pliers
- Apron
- Taps 4-40 and/or 6-32
- Drill bit set #1-#60
